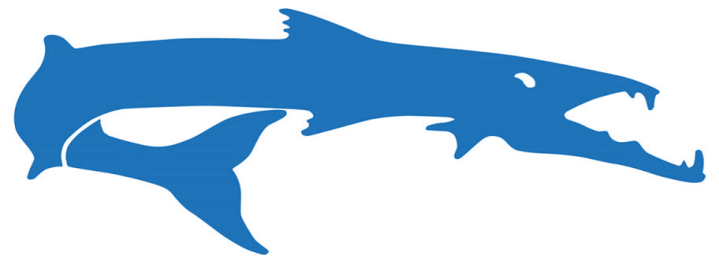

- Must possess the knowledge and ability to teach all competitive strokes, rules and regulations to athletes.
- Must be able to plan practice sessions and swim meets, bring creative programming ideas to the team, organize and maintain equipment, and show a responsible attitude toward the team.
- Develop positive relationships with athletes and parents, encourage involvement, and provide motivational support and guidance.
- Ensure safety of athletes during practices and meets.
- Attend staff meetings, trainings, and swim meets as scheduled.
- Maintain updated certifications, safety trainings and background checks at all times.
- Adhere to all policies and procedures of the YMCA of Middletown and of USA Swimming.

USA Swimming Certifications, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, Basic First Aid certification.
