## Camp Funshine / Summer Squad Details

**EXPLORERS | AGES 3-5:** Campers are encouraged to socialize and interact with each other during activities that help them develop fine and gross motor skills, build self-confidence, and make new friends. Explorers experience new learning adventures every day! **Please Note: Camper must turn 3 by July 1 and Must Be Fully Potty Trained. 5 Year olds registering for this group have not yet entered Kindergarten. Explorers are NOT eligible for Bonus Week.**

**PIONEERS | AGES 5-7:** Participate in all the traditional camp activities while learning to appreciate diversity, improve social skills, and develop leadership skills while having fun making lasting summer camp memories. **Please Note: 5 Year olds registering for this group must have completed Kindergarten.**

**SUMMER SQUAD AGES | 8-12:** Participate in traditional sports, games, arts and crafts, swimming, leadership development and outdoor camp activities.

**L.I.T ( LEADERS IN TRAINING ) | AGES 13-14:** Volunteer in service projects and participate in traditional camp activities like swimming and sports. This program prepares teens for positions as future C.I.T.'S and gives them the tools needed become future camp counselors.

**C.I.T ( Counselors IN TRAINING ) | AGES 15-16:** Participants learn the skills needed to become future camp counselors by shadowing our camp counselors working with our younger campers. To be eligible for this free program, CIT applicants must have completed 2 years of summer camp, one of which in our LIT program and will go through an interview process with the Camp Director. Letters of recommendation that attest to leadership skills are encouraged. Once accepted into the program, CIT's will be required to attend an orientation and trainings.
